Happy Schools Project – 100 Schools @ ₹ 5.60 crores (₹5.6 lakhs per school) involves

- Revamping the existing infrastructure
 - Setup library, science laboratories, computer laboratory & provide e-learning equipment
- Establish e-learning centers in all schools
- Health & Hygiene, including safe drinking water provision
- Teacher Support in all schools
- Coverage Areas: Chikkaballapur, Anekal and Bengaluru Urban Districts

Happy Schools Project

- Pulse Polio is a project where Rotary has demonstrated how collective and focused efforts helped reduce the incidence of the disease by 99.9%. India has remained Polio free for over 8 years now
- After the success of Pulse Polio project, Rotary leadership in India embarked on another mission of making India 100% literate & improve the quality of education. It launched **T.E.A.C.H.** mission
 - T** Teacher Support
 - E** E-Learning
 - A** Adult Literacy
 - C** Child Development – 360 degrees
 - H** Happy School
- RBJ has set out to create **100 Happy Schools** in the upcoming year under T.E.A.C.H. mission

Happy Schools Project

Our past experience with T.E.A.C.H.

- TEACH Mission has proved to be highly successful in increasing attendance at school, improving infrastructure, introducing new teaching methods and improve literacy
- RBJ in past has taken up some schools under TEACH mission & considering its positive outcome, in 2019-20 has extended it to Gubbalala, a tiny village located 500 meters off Kanakapura main road in Bangalore covering **5 Government schools**, comprising of **1600 students**, including boys & girls
- RBJ has provided over a period of time Library, Kannada to English dictionaries, E-Learning kits, desks, R.O. drinking water plant, toilet block, utensils for mid day meals, wash basin and soap supply for 2 years under Rotary WINS (Wash In Schools) program and painting of the School

Happy Schools Project

Our past experience with T.E.A.C.H.

Resulted in

- I. Number of girl students enrolment has increased to 65%
- II. Attendance has improved
- III. Students are more confident
- IV. More Students can read, write and speak English
- V. Better discipline in the school
- VI. Drop out rate has reduced
- VII. Children are aware of Hygiene

Happy Schools Project

Project Estimation

- To provide 9 pillars of Happy School requires investment of ₹5 lakhs per school on an average
- E-Learning + Teacher support cost per school - ₹60,000
- Plan is to cover 100 schools – $100 * (5L + 60k) = ₹5.6 \text{ cr}$

Role of Donor

- Contribute 100% towards the project

Role of Rotary Bangalore Junction

- Identify needs of each school, finalize vendors & supervise project execution till completion

Project Implementation & Monitoring

- A joint committee of the corporate & Rotarians to be set up for monitoring and execution at the time of signing an agreement
- Joint committee to list out the budget, priorities and phased execution – 2/3 weeks from agreement
- Firm estimates for work to be obtained within 2 weeks of joint committee decision
- Assessment, negotiations and award of work – within 2 weeks of disbursement of funds by the corporate
- Joint committee between corporates and Rotary Bangalore Junction to regularly track & report status periodically
